## **Standard Response Protocol**

## SRP

- Hold
- Secure
- Lockdown
- Evacuate
- Shelter

Monthly Drills Always check-in at the office Safety features of the building

## IN AN EMERGENCY **TAKE ACTION**

#### HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

#### STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced Do business as usual

#### ADULTS Close and lock the door Account for students and adults Do business as usual

#### SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS Return to inside of building Do business as usual

ADULTS Bring everyone indoors Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students and adults Do business as usual



#### LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door

ADULTS Recover students from hallway if possible Lock the classroom door Turn out the lights Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend



#### **EVACUATE!** (A location may be specified) STUDENTS ADULTS

Leave stuff behind if required to If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

Lead students to Evacuation location Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults




#### SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy. STUDENTS ADULTS

Safety Strategy Seal the room


Evacuate to shelter area Drop, cover and hold Get to high ground

# INNOVATION


During Innovation Time, students will be participating in a series of hands-on, pupil driven activities using the lens of neuroscience and design thinking.
